JAYNE'S JOTTINGS



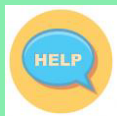
WANTED – NELLIE NUTTALL

Has anyone got a spare plant or cutting of Nellie Nuttall. Sadly Keith Cocking has lost his and is eager to replace it.

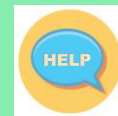
SHOW NEWS

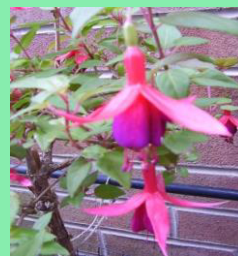

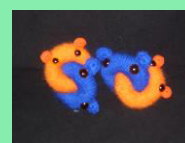
◀**Thanks Patricia** – a while back, Patricia handed me this bundle of crocheted motifs and asked if they could be turned into something useful.
