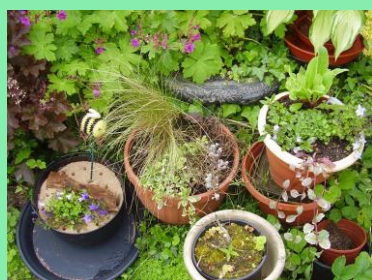

POEM OF THE MONTH

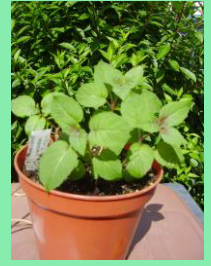
Nature is a wonderful thing... Sometimes we forget the smallest of creatures...

SHOW NEWS

I thought it worth mentioning again some of the changes this year which were mentioned in January 2023 Newsletter: -

CHANGES AGREED BY THE COMMITTEE:

- **New Venue: -**
 - Stapleford Methodist Church
Eatons' Road
Stapleford
Nottingham
NG9 7EA
- **1 day Show** - Show will now only be held on the Saturday, 2nd Saturday in August.
- **Maximum 3 entries per class**
- **2 ½" Class** – this will remain.
- **Children's class** – this is to be resurrected.
- **No Prize Money**
- **Engraving** – The Committee agreed to continue funding the engraving as it keeps a sound audit trail. Also by no longer awarding prize money, this will cover the cost of engraving.

PLEASE NOTE: -

- Unlike some Shows, we do **NOT** require pre-registration of exhibits, therefore, exhibitors, please bring along your entry form on the day of staging and hand to Show Secretary on arrival to allow him to complete the necessary Exhibitor and Cultivar Name cards.
- Stapleford Methodist Church have requested that we do **NOT** park on the slabs which lead up to the church to avoid damaging the slabs. (There should be room on the drive to unload exhibits – unless everyone arrives at the same time!).
- Care should also be taken if parking on the road directly in front of the church, as there is a nasty traffic warden!
